



Parking and Transportation Guide for Super Bowl LI

The Super Bowl is upon us, and with it comes numerous events for fans, residents and visitors. With those events also comes increased traffic and parking concerns.

Whether you live in the Houston area or are visiting from out of town, refer to this transportation guide before you head out to the various Super Bowl activities.

Parking Availability

Downtown Houston has more than 62,000 spots for Super Bowl-related events. Fans are encouraged to park on the west side of downtown to ride the Special Event Circulators to their destination. Certain lots may not be utilized in their normal capacity, so it is recommended attendees plan ahead when deciding where to park. If you're coming downtown during business hours Monday to Friday, there will still be 12,000-plus designated fan parking spots during that time. Parking lots with available space will be available on the Host Committee website and on the Super Bowl app.

Meters

There are more than 1,000 street parking spaces available from 2-hour to 4-hour increments. There are three different ways to pay at the pay station:

- Pay-by-Plate: Enter your license plate number to pay
- Pay-by-Phone: Download the app PayByPhone or dial a toll-free number (877) 727-5953
- Pay-and-Display: Pay meter & display the receipt on your dashboard

Pre-Paid Parking App

Guests may pre-purchase their parking spot for any event downtown at a guaranteed rate through the Host Committee app and website. The parking pass can be printed or scanned through the app that provides turn-by-turn directions to the lots. The pre-paid option will be available in both locations in late December.

Host Committee members advise guests allow extra time when traveling downtown due to event-specific road closures and detours.

Metro

Public transportation is recommended to access downtown Houston for Super Bowl-related events. METRO will offer extended event schedules, increased frequency and additional circulators and shuttles.



Accessible Parking

If you plan to drive downtown, there are more than 62,000 parking spots available during peak event hours. However, Host Committee members strongly encourage attendees to secure parking in advance through the Super Bowl Host Committee website or app.

Taxi, Uber

No matter where you're headed, Uber connects you with a reliable ride in minutes. One tap and a car comes directly to you. Your driver knows exactly where to go, and payment is completely cashless. In addition to 24/7 pickups throughout the city, the Houston Super Bowl Host Committee has partnered with Uber to provide a designated pickup and drop-off zone around Super Bowl LIVE. The location is at the Super Bowl LIVE Welcome Center on Rusk Street between Crawford Street and Avenida de las Americas. New to Uber? Download the app and enter promo code HOU2017 to get your first ride free (up to \$15).

Bike Valet

BikeHouston will provide a bike valet at Super Bowl LIVE to store guests' bikes while they enjoy the festivities at Super Bowl LIVE. The bike valet will be available during Super Bowl LIVE operating hours and will be located on Caroline Street between Clay and Dallas Streets.

Feb. 5, 2017 Game Day

Ticketholders have multiple options to get to NRG Park on game day. Parking passes are available, METRO will run modified schedules, and Uber/taxis will have designated drop-off areas. Fans are encouraged to arrive early to enjoy the Game Day Fan Plaza. Tickets are required for all NRG events on game day.



Road Closures

Whether you're going to Super Bowl LIVE, NFL Experience or any event downtown, keep in mind:

- Polk Street (Between Austin and LaBranch)
- Dallas Street (Between Austin and LaBranch)
- LaBranch Street (Between Walker and Bell)

Recommendations

Drivers are encouraged to park on the West side of downtown Houston and shuttle or walk to Avenida Houston and Super Bowl LIVE. Street closures may impact commutes on the east side of town. Note that certain exits, streets, and parking areas may not be available during special events downtown.

Trains & Busses

ETRO will provide additional trains and buses with extended hours of operation.

Alternate Transportation

Greenlink, with its three routes: Green Route, Orange Route and Silver Route is a free circulator in downtown Houston that will transport attendees from the parking lots on the west side of downtown to the entrance to Super Bowl LIVE in and around Discovery Green.

METRO will have special connectors from the Galleria to downtown for a fare of \$2 each way.

The Midtown circulator connects METRORail's Red Line with popular spots and ESPN's broadcast center at Midtown Park. It does not connect with specific parking lots.

Uber

Uber is an easy way to request a reliable and affordable ride within minutes. The Uber mobile app connects riders with their ride and offers real-time tracking of their vehicle from start to finish. We have partnered with Uber to provide a designated pick-up and drop-off zone around Super Bowl LIVE presented by Verizon which will make the wait time and surge charging minimal. The location is at the Super Bowl LIVE presented by Verizon Welcome Center on Rusk Street between Crawford Street and Avenida de las Americas.

Taxicabs

There are numerous locations and areas to get picked up and dropped off should guests choose to travel by taxi. Six in the City -- a \$6 taxicab ride anywhere downtown by any taxi company in Houston -- is also available. Taxicab stands are located around downtown and can be found on the City of Houston's new rideshare app, ARRO.

Houston B-Cycle

Pedal your way to a Super Bowl LI event courtesy of Houston B-cycle. A bike-share program will be offered during Super Bowl LI week.

Bike Valet

Guests can park their bikes at a bike valet, courtesy of BikeHouston. The Bike Valet is located at Super Bowl LIVE on Caroline Street between Clay and Dallas Streets and is open during posted Super Bowl LIVE operating hours

Pedicabs

Certified vendors will be available on the north side of Discovery Green and will travel anywhere in the Central Business District.

METRO Rail

The METRORail Red Line connects Downtown Houston and NRG Park with service every 4 minutes during peak game-day hours. Guests can connect via METROBus or METRORail Purple and Green Lines at the Central Main Street station. The ride from downtown to NRG is approximately 17 minutes and costs \$1.25 each way. Fares can be purchased in advance via the METRO app.

Connectors

Guests staying in the Galleria area can hop on the METROBus to and from NRG Park. This route will leave at specified times to and from the game for one flat fee of \$2 each way or \$4 round-trip. For more information please visit www.ridemetro.org.

ADA

For guests with disabilities, METRO offers 100 percent accessibility and also provides paratransit via METROLift. Call (713)-225-0119 for more information.



Taxi Stand

Taxis will be available in the Brown Lot of NRG Park. To call a taxi to get to the game prior to kick-off, guests are urged to use the ARRO smartphone app.

Uber Lot

Ubers will drop off and pickup from the Maroon lot at NRG Park.
